We have had **NEW CHROME LAPTOPS** set up today and they will be a super improvement to our IT provision.

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On Friday there will be **A DAY OF POSITIVITY** at school. Alongside National and local events, we will be promoting further eco-friendly approaches, as well as raising awareness of the need for change.
