What is the P.F.A?

Newtown Parents and Friends Association is a registered charity that works alongside the school to raise funds to enhance and support the teaching that Newtown can offer. Funds are raised through events such as raffles, fairs, quiz nights and discos before then being used to subsidise the cost of school trips, pay for resources, fund workshops and fund the Year 6 leavers' celebration. All of the monies raised by the P.F.A go towards enriching every child's time at Newtown.

Even though last year was a quiet year, we were able to raise funds that have already been distributed through the school to subsidise school trips. Each class has been allocated £400.00 to reduce the costs of trips – this makes them more affordable for everyone.

Getting involved

Every parent by default is a member of the P.F.A., but we are a committee chaired by Jodie Pownall (George and Darcey's Mum). Thank you to Jade Bowden (Jenson and Preston's Mum) for her time as treasurer and to Amy Barker who has now taken the role over. However, we always need people to step forward and get involved and help, we cannot raise the funds needed to support the school alone.

New committee members are required to maintain the success and running of the P.F.A. However, any amount of help is always welcome - there are always raffle tickets to be folded, tea to be poured and cakes to be baked (and eaten!). Involvement within the P.F.A. does not need to be hugely time consuming - the more people that get involved the lighter the load.
