On Thursday 26th May 2022, Thornsett will be hosting our very own celebration for the Queen's Jubilee. We will have a normal morning in school, followed by an exciting afternoon of delicious food, bouncy castles, sports, dancing, crafts and fun.

At 11:30am, we will walk down to the field as a whole school, in time to enjoy a special Jubilee picnic lunch which will be provided by school. **All families are invited to join us for our picnic lunch, but ask that you bring your own picnic – ready to eat with us at 12 noon.** Once we have finished eating, we will begin the activities, and each class will rotate around three different areas throughout the afternoon. We are inviting our families to stay and join in with the whole afternoon. There will be a cake and drink gazebo where you can treat yourself to something delicious, as well as a raffle with some excellent prizes. All money raised will go towards enrichment activities for the children next half term.

The activities are as follows:

- Street party games and wildflower planting
- Bouncy castle and a tennis coach
- Time Capsule and crafts

We will finish our Jubilee celebration with a whole school Barn Dance, led by Mr Parry, and a Thornsett rendition of God Save the Queen.

As part of the Time Capsule activity, we would like to take a photo of every child, and they will then write their contribution beneath their photo and name. Our Thornsett Time Capsule will then be buried somewhere on the school field, and will be a snapshot of our 2022 Jubilee Celebration for someone to find, perhaps in a hundred years! As part of the celebrations, we are also inviting children to take part in a few 'village fete' competitions. The children can take part in as many of these as they wish, and their creations will be displayed for the families to see on the day. We will be asking our school governors to judge the competition and choose 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners. The competitions are as follows:

- Bake a Cake: make a cake at home and bring it in on the day.
- Make a Crown: in keeping with the celebrations, we are asking the children to create their best crown fit for a royal! Bring it to school on the day and we will see whose crown is suitable for the Queen.
- Photography Show: experiment with a camera and take some photos. Who can capture a beautiful, funny, artistic or creative moment? Bring in your photos and we'll soon find out!

We will dismiss the children **from the school field at normal time**. Please also make sure you send your child into school with weather appropriate accessories (hopefully a sun hat and sun cream and not a raincoat and wellies!)
