BREAKFAST CLUB

Thornsett School breakfast club is run by dedicated members of staff who give up their own time to support the school. It has grown in size dramatically over the last 12 months (the older children have also been given some responsibility to help the younger children when they arrive. – something they thoroughly enjoy doing).

School has to run a tight schedule in order to get everyone fed and watered in time before school starts. Due to the larger numbers we need to change a few procedures to make this work!

As from **MONDAY 26TH SEPTEMBER**, we will be starting breakfast club earlier.

Please can we ask that all parents who bring their children to breakfast club ensure they drop them off at **8.00am**. This will ensure that all the children have time to eat their breakfast as we don't want to be rushing them through. The hall is also used for teaching and staff have to ensure that everything is tidied away before they can start their duties in class. Children arriving after 8.15am will therefore be offered food that requires no clean up (cereal bars, bag of dried fruit, piece of fruit).

Please book in for breakfast club with Mrs Tinker in the office at the earliest possible time so that any extra supplies can be purchased accordingly.

We are keeping the charge at £1.50 however, the cost of food and provisions are continuing to rise. Please be assured that if we do need to increase the charge, it will only be a small amount to meet these rising costs.
