Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to invite all of the children of High Peak Federation (Newtown and Thornsett Primary Schools) to join in a day of fun and games to celebrate the coronation of King Charles III. This will take place on Thursday 4th May 2023, as a full school day, on Thornsett Primary School field, Portland Road, New Mills. The day will start as a normal day, so children should come to school as normal. Each school will make their way to the site shortly after registration in the morning, so prompt arrival at school is necessary for all on the day.

The morning will involve a range of fun games, activities, crafts and surprises that children will move around in year groups. Lunch will be provided for all children as a special coronation 'afternoon tea'. The afternoon will see more activities and end with a rousing rendition of 'God Save the King'.

Parents are invited to join us from lunchtime onwards. If attending for lunch, please bring your lunch with you. We would ask that you take home with you any rubbish you produce, do not bring alcohol, and do not bring extra food for children, who will have a more than adequate lunch provided already. Refreshments will be available for a donation, and any monies raised will go towards funding the day.

Newtown children will leave the site at around 14:30, to return to school and be dismissed as normal at the end of the school day.

Thornsett children will be dismissed from the school field from 15:00 onwards (we will stay at the site until the end of the normal school day for those that may struggle to get there for pick up at 1500).

To make the celebration extra special we would like to invite children to take part in one or both of two competitions that should be submitted the day before the garden party and will be judged on the day. Winners will be announced on the afternoon of the garden party by our mystery guest judges. Information about these competitions is attached on separate sheets. They will be judged in two groups: EYFS/KS1, and KS2 and there will be Bronze, Silver and Gold awards for each competition in each group.

This will be an exciting day of fun, laughter and bonding for all children, staff and parents who get involved. Please contact staff in your own school if you would like to discuss any more details about the day.
